At the heart of the day will be our hub in Otley Parish Church. This is a wonderful space and will accommodate 20+ stands, appealing not just to coffee lovers, but to a wide range of visitors. Whilst coffee tasting will be at the heart of the experience, there will be stands with food to complement coffee; coffee equipment; other beverages; art and other merchandise. Some of our exhibitors will have a regional (and increasingly national) profile, some will be unashamedly local. All are based in Yorkshire and proud of it! Alongside the exhibition, there will be a line-up of some of Otley's best musicians, and a talks programme to appeal to all coffee lovers, whatever your level of expertise. Tickets and Times

Tickets for the festival will be only £6 in advance or £7.50 on the door. We believe this is ridiculously good value!

The festival is open from 10 until 4. Advance tickets are timed, so you need to decide when you want to arrive. Once in, you can stay as long as you like.
